Que Beleza Brasil! Presents Lulu Santos

A Conversation with the Students of Ronald W. Reagan Doral

A natural hit maker, writer of countless classics with millions in sales throughout a career spanning more than 4 decades and 30 albums, Lulu Santos is undoubtedly one of the greatest Brazilian music artists of all time.

Since the late 1970's Lulu Santos has been a dominant and influential figure on the music scene at a level rarely seen in South America for a pop artist. From the outset, he released a series of hits that became instant classics, such as "Tempos Modernos", "Tudo Azul", "Toda Forma de Amor", "Um Certo Alguém", "Assim caminha a humanidade", and "De Repente Califórnia." The 1984 album *Tudo Azul* is considered one of the most important in Brazilian pop/rock, and influenced the generations of musicians that followed. His live performances are epic celebrations of love, a constant theme throughout his career. Lulu Santos performed at the historic first edition of Rock in Rio in 1985, and most recently at the 2019 edition.
