Award-winning Chef Vicky will share her love for and deep knowledge of Haiti's cuisine and rich culinary history. Her virtual cooking demonstration will highlight dishes from different regions of Haiti and expose participants to the richness of Haitian Creole's culinary-related vocabulary and expressions.

Upon leaving Haiti in 1994, Chef Vicky dreamed of one day representing Haiti on the national stage, and in 2012 that dream came to fruition when she was called to join Haiti's team as a culinary chef ambassador for the Caribbean Tourism Association Taste of the Caribbean competition. After competing against 11 other Caribbean nations, Chef Vicky was awarded the sliver medal and joined the ranks of the most talented chefs from the Caribbean. Chef Vicky attended culinary school at Le Cordon Bleu Miami and holds a bachelor's degree in hospitality restaurant management and a master's degree in dietetics and nutrition, both from FIU.
