Dr. Mauro Galetti will present on his research, which is oriented to understand the effects of human impact on the biodiversity of tropical ecosystems.

Mauro Galetti is a Full Professor at São Paulo State University (UNESP), Brazil and Associate Visiting Professor at the Kimberly Green Latin American and Caribbean Center (LACC) at Florida International University. Professor Galetti has a PhD at Cambridge University in the United Kingdom and has long experience in tropical ecology. He has worked in Brazil, Indonesia and the Caribbean. With more than 200 papers published, he was considered one of the most influential scientists in 2019, 2020 and 2021 by Clarivate Analytics.
