## Foreign Language and Area Studies (FLAS) Fellowships Final Call for Applications

2015 Summer Fellowships Application Submission Deadline: April 21, 2015

The Latin American and Caribbean Center (LACC) at Florida International University is privileged to announce a call for applications for the Foreign Language and Area Studies (FLAS) Fellowship.

The FLAS fellowship supports language training in Less-Commonly-Taught Languages (LCTLs), including Portuguese, Haitian Creole, and Quechua. The fellowship assists in the advancement of knowledge, resources, and trained personnel for foreign language and area/international studies and supports the development of a qualified pool of international experts with global competence designed to meet U.S. national needs.

The Summer FLAS fellowship covers tuition and fees (up to \$5,000) for the summer semester. Additionally, fellowship recipients are awarded a stipend (approximately \$2,500 for undergraduate and graduate students).

Full-time, degree-seeking FIU graduate and undergraduate students in any discipline who are focusing their study on Latin America may apply. FLAS Fellowship recipients are required to complete at least one Latin American and Caribbean-related area studies course and one Portuguese, Haitian Creole, or Quechua course during the summer semester.

Summer fellowships are offered to students participating in FLAS approved Summer Study Abroad programs only. Non-FIU students participating in LACC's Haitian Summer Institute are eligible to apply. **Students must confirm the FLAS approved Summer Study Abroad program of their choice is still accepting applications**. Undergraduate and graduate student recipients must be prepared to study one of the approved languages at the intermediate or advanced level. **Graduate students at the beginning level will be considered for overseas language study only if an appropriate equivalent beginning language instruction program in the target language is not available in the United States.** Proof of proficiency will be required for students applying for the FLAS Fellowship. Students in the professional schools (Business, Law, Medicine, Journalism, Social Work, Engineering, etc.) and those planning a career in U.S. government service are strongly encouraged to apply.
