Juan Carlos Botero is an influential and widely-read author and journalist. He was born in Bogota, Colombia and studied literature at La Universidad de los Andes, Harvard University and Universidad Javeriana. He has written columns for leading Colombian newspapers including: La Prensa, El Tiempo and El Espectador, where he still works as a columnist. Botero has received critical acclaim for his literary work. In 1986, he was awarded the Juan Rulfo Prize for Latin American and Caribbean Literature for “El encuentro,” and in 1990, “El descenso” was selected as the winner of Mexico’s XIX Concurso Latinoamericano de Cuento. His novels include *La sentencia* and *El arrecife*, and in 2010, Botero published the book *El arte de Fernando Botero*. He is currently working on his next novel entitled *Los hechos casuales*.
